- Proposed Truck Stop:
- The District received (July 15th, 2021) information regarding a proposed Truck Stop near Howard and Park. Initial draft comments are submitted under separate cover.
- Recommended Action: Authorize delivery of a response to the proposed development and to participate in communications for the purpose of information gathering.
- Other:
- It is noted that a couple of developers have approached the District with questions regarding water and sewer capacity to support additional development. General information has been provided. It is recommended that developers be required to submit written requests to the District to determine what level of effort is appropriate and what costs the developers would be required to cover.
- 2) INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING
 - a) Well and Waterline Replacement Project
 - Near term activity for August:
 - Work will focus on final water service connections, modification of Well2A, continued progress on Well 6, work on Well 5 and water line improvements in the alley behind the elevated tank.
 - b) Pine Street Sewer Project
 - The project has been awarded for construction.
 - Recommended Action: Board's pleasure. Potholing of the storm drain at Pine and Ellsworth has not yet been performed.
 - c) Well 5 Emergency Repairs
 - The project is underway. The additional acid brushing has been completed and the pump is re-installed into the well. The well will be pumped to waste until clean and then returned to service.
 - Recommended Action: Board's pleasure
- 3) FUNDING ASSISTANCE APPLICATION
 - a) Interim Emergency Drinking Water and Drought Related Drinking Water Funding
 - The State approved a grant of \$151,038 to Pixley PUD to install vending machines. The term of the project is form 05/03/2021 to 06/30/2022. First steps are to complete and submit (by August 3, 2021) to the State the Project Director Certification and Payee Data Records forms (STD204 and STD 205). It is recommended that Jennifer Blevins is designated as the Project Director. The Project Director needs to be a direct employee of the District. Once these documents have been reviewed by the State, a Grant Agreement will be routed to the District for execution.
 - Recommended Action: Authorize completion, execution, and submittal of the Project Director Certification and Payee Data Record forms STD 204 and STD 205.
- 4) TCP PLANNING GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

- 5) IRWM GRANT TO EVALUATE IMPROVING THE WATER LINE NORTH OF COURT ALONG PARK.
 - The authorized design work is complete.
 - A Notice of Determination has been recorded for the project.
 - An encroachment application to cross State Route 99 as been submitted to Caltrans.
 - Funding assistance opportunities are being investigated.
 - Recommended Action: Board's Pleasure.
- 6) WATER RECLAMATION AGREEMENT
 - A new Report of Waste of Discharge is being prepared.
 - Recommended Action: Authorize submittal of the Report of Waste Discharge to the RWQCB and DDW.
