- 2) PIXLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
 - The Pixley Unified School District elementary school intends to construct improvements at the elementary school site. It is expected that the Pixley Unified School District will submit formal communication describing the proposed improvements.
- 3) INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING
 - a) Well and Waterline Replacement Project
 - The project has been advertised. A walk-through meeting with Contractors is scheduled for June 3 at 10:00 am. The Bid Opening is scheduled for June 18 at 2:00 pm. The State, County, Pixley ID, and other agencies have been made aware of the project for either funding or coordination purposes.
 - An amendment to the Engineering Services Agreement is requested for consideration. The project requires specific environmental investigations if the project construction period is going to be between February 1 and August 31.
 - Recommended Action: Approve the Amendment, subject to USDA authorization.
 - USDA Loan Resolution form: The project is advertised, and it is now the time to take action relative to a specific USDA Loan Resolution document.
